This month marks one year since the launch of '[Knowing me, Knowing UKSG: Scholarly Comms Journeys](#)', a podcast series for the scholarly communications sector.

The podcast is a platform where professionals can share their unique stories, experiences, and reflections, creating a dialogue that will inspire and inform the next generation of leaders in our sector. It's for those who want to expand their knowledge, be inspired by the journeys of others, and gain insights that will help them in their own careers.
